



#### **F&DJFL FOOTBALL REPORT**

The Frankston & District Junior Football League (F&DJFL) once again delivered a complete season in 2023, with a couple new and exciting additions to the league. These additions included the introduction of regional football with the South East Juniors (SEJ) in the U13 and U14 age groups (mixed and girls), the beginning of the F&DJFL U8 Girls competition and the re-introduction of U16 Boys football.

6,411 players, 533 coaches and 2,728 volunteers represented the league across 41 divisions, culminating in a 14 rounds home and away season with premiership cups and flags presented in August 2023.

Season 2023 saw another increase in participation in the F&DJFL by 145 players, resulting in an increase of over 850 participants since the return of football post COVID-19. 1,561 females registered in 2023, an increase of 109 from the previous season and 4,850 males registered in 2023, an increase of 36 from 2022. This season had 107 teams across the 'modified' age groups (U8 to U10), 69 teams in the U11 and U12 age brackets along with 59 teams in the U13 and U14 regional age groups and 58 teams in the U15 to U19 brackets.

The F&DJFL was represented by 18 clubs in 2023 with no changes from the 2022 season.

#### **F&DJFL INTERLEAGUE**

Cam Roberts – St Kilda Football Club - Academy Lead

St Kilda Football Club continued their long-standing relationship with FDJFL in 2023 with great success.

As per tradition the Saints started out the year with the open Come & Try day and athlete testing before finalisation of the six (6) squads leading into a March start. The coaching team and talent staff, led by Paddy Swayn and Mat Hose respectively, are genuinely committed to identifying talent and providing a connected environment for developing their fundamental football and life skills.

For the first time the Saints formed an U13 Girls team led by Ellie Dash from Langwarrin JFC. Whilst this squad of 50 girls weren't formally involved in the AFL SE Junior Championships they culminated their training program with an intraclub game as part of the July school holidays. We can't wait to see how well these girls progress in their 14th year in 2024 as we continue to add in suitable talent and help drive female participation in the region.

Within the AFL South East Junior Championships the FDJFL Saints fielded teams in all age groups across both divisions. St Kilda Academy participants from U13 Boys, U14 Boys & Girls, U15 Boys and U15 Girls (playing up in an U16 Girls team) represented their league and clubs with great enthusiasm and skill. The league was also represented in the Boys U16, Boys U17 and Girls U18 age groups in the Division 1 championships. A big thank you to all the academy and interleague staff for continually giving up their time for the players which eventually led to success in winning six of the eight age groups.



The Saints are also very keen to be involved in Division 2 games throughout the school holidays as this not only provides an opportunity for further players within the squads but on occasion where required we are able to upgrade talent from watchlists to participate. Players continue to progress and develop their games and bodies at different rates and the dialogue to all these teenagers is always to show resilience, be patient and work hard. There are many stories every year of players that miss interleague representation but seize their chances in their later teen years.



In November the academy squads returned in the U13 and U14 age groups with some newly identified players and coaches added to the mix. Focussing on education the 4 week November block provided a chance to expose the players to running technique, tackling instruction and nutrition. We also started up the second tier U17 offering for boys and girls in conjunction with our talent partner the Dandenong Stingrays. Around 50 boys and 50 girls just below the Stingrays futures level were offered the chance to do a preseason program which culminates in early 2024 with games against the Stingrays futures team. This is the only program of it's type in the state with Tori De Groot taking charge of the Girls 17s whilst the super committed Peter Freeman heads up the Boys 17s in his 7th year as an academy coach.

All in all another fantastic year in the red, black and white out of the upgraded Healthy Futures Hub facility in Seaford. A huge thanks to the players, their parents for supporting their football and to our amazing academy and interleague staff for their dedication. A special thanks to South Hub Coordinator Bailey Berry who has taken the reigns brilliantly throughout the year and to our AFL South East stakeholders including Fraser Bayne (Commissioner) for their continued support.

#### **UMPIRE REPORT**

I am pleased to present the Annual Report for the AFL South East Umpiring Department, reflecting on the remarkable year that was 2023. It is my privilege to report on the achievements, challenges, and the tireless efforts of our dedicated team. The past year has been characterized by growth, excellence, and a commitment to raising the standards of umpiring within our region.

#### **ACKNOWLEDGMENTS & TRANSITIONS**

Before delving into the details, I would like to express our heartfelt gratitude to Dean Armstrong, who served as the Umpire Operations Coordinator from June until late November. Dean played a crucial role in guiding AFL South East Umpiring during this period, and his contributions have been invaluable. We extend our sincere thanks to him for his dedication and leadership.

#### **UMPIRE RECRUITMENT & APPOINTMENT RATES**

In 2022, our region faced a challenge with an average of 70% of matches being filled. The registered umpire count increased from 409 to 644, contributing to a significant improvement in match appointment rates. For the MPFNL, an impressive milestone was achieved, with 100% of matches having Field Umpires appointed. Similarly, the SEWF witnessed a commendable 98% appointment rate, reflecting the commitment of our umpires to officiate at the highest standards. In our Junior competitions, over 90% of matches had Field Umpires appointed, showcasing the growth and development of our young umpires. This achievement would not have been possible without the dedication of our existing umpires, the recruitment efforts of our team, and the support of the broader AFL South East community. It is a testament to the collaborative spirit that defines our region.

### APPOINTMENT OF RUSSELL DAVIDSON (Field Umpires Coach)

In a significant development, we welcomed Russell Davidson as the AFL South East Field Umpires Coach. Russell's appointment comes on the heels of his recognition as the AFL Victoria Coach of the Year in 2022, and we are fortunate to have him on board.
