

SEJ FOOTBALL REPORT

South East Juniors (SEJ) had a successful 2023 season with some exciting new additions to the competition which included the inaugural U10 girls competition, regional football with SEJ and Frankston & District Junior Football League (F&DJFL) combining the U13 and U14 age groups, and the re-introduction of the U16 boys age group.

2023 also saw the introduction of the 'SEJ Academy' interleague program for Under 13 to 15 boys and under 14 to 16 girls.

4,379 players, 477 coaches and 1,373 volunteers represented the SEJ across 39 divisions, with a 14 round home and away season and subsequent finals ending with premiership flags presented in 2023.

2023 had an increase of 372 players in the SEJ from 2022, highlighting the competitions rebuilding and increased growth in the female football space. This was a refreshing statistic after a significant drop in 2022. 798 females represented the SEJ in 2023 which was an increase of over 100 while the boys numbers also increased from 2022.

The SEJ was represented by 17 clubs in 2023, a reduction of one club after the departure of Tooradin JFC. 64 teams completed the 'modified' U8 to U10 age groups, 38 teams in the U11 and U12 spaces, 33 teams in the U13 and U14 regional grades and 41 teams in the U15 to U19 age groups.

LITTLE DEMONS DAY

Little Demons Day 2023 was again partners with Melbourne FC at Casey Fields (VFL Oval) for U8s, 9s and 10s age groups. This year saw an all girls clinic hosted in the Indoor Training Facility (ITF) to launch the newly established U10 Girls competition.

For the first time, the event was held prior to round 1 and utilised as a pre-season event to assist clubs set up for the season ahead. It was also promoted as a registration driver for clubs. Each team participate in 2-3 modified matches which provided players and officials alike to gain match day experience on a smaller scale while also creating a carnival type atmosphere at Casey Fields.

SEJ ACADEMY & SEJ INTERLEAGUE

SEJ GIRLS

Sean Chamberlain – SEJ Academy Girls Head Coach

This year we saw the revamp of the SEJ (Melbourne) Academy. Having Hope Smith overseeing the administration of the program was fantastic. What was very impressive was the Combine Testing day held in Keysborough by Rookie Me (Parents were Blown Away) But for me The SEJ Academy apparel stood out and looked fantastic the whole year.

Kicking off in February with come try days for nominated players and Division 2 from previous Year, of which we saw great numbers turn up. This year Starting in March with the girls Academy program we had U14 & U16 having approximately 50 participants in each age group. Tim Ferguson and myself created a training program for all age groups that was designed for a lot of craft work and game sense drills. Set in 3-4 week blocks, then adding to the drills to increase intensity and pressure.

For the girls training sessions there would always be high standards for pre training craft followed by a very impressively run strength and conditioning warm up. The sessions consisted of 3-4 craft rotations, followed by two larger game sense drills accumulating all the craft drills into game sense.



Leading up to the Queens Birthday weekend Interleague carniva) our Div 1 & Div 2 Teams were picked and announced but we still would train each age group as one. We also established an U12 Team was formed and got to play a game against West Gippsland. U18 Girls came in for the remaining 4 week block to get to know each other. The carnival was fantastic seeing what we had been Coaching over the past 8 weeks coming out in Games was brilliant.All players were played in multiple positions and equal time for all on the bench was fulfilled to our best ability.

Results for Games was not the focus but each age group did everything we asked them to do as an Academy and enjoyment was seen to be had by all.







SEJ BOYS

Tim Ferguson - SEJ Academy Boys Head Coach

SEJ's Academy for 2023 was put together with a lot of thought, planning, time, effort and perseverance to deliver a program that would engage and stimulate all players from U13's to U15's. Our focus was strongly directed at fundamentals of the game, leading into game sense drills which would in turn help develop the players to understand match simulation awareness to apply in games.

Our Stage 1 program started in November 2022 across 4 weeks, which included training with Dandenong Stingrays, Gippsland Power and Casey Demons VFL all taking training on various nights. This was enthusiastically received by both players and coaches in understanding what is required to take the next steps and open all our eyes to a more professional approach in our football journey. Recommencing in February 2023 with Stage 2, run by Rookie Me. This involved another 4 week program including a combine testing day which was well received from players and families, as the visual perspective was simply outstanding.

The commencement of Stage 3 after our first release of players began in March with a final release of players allowing us to select our Division 1 and 2 sides. We were now ready to enter the interleague carnival, after a 20 week program.



Our Stage 1 program started in November 2022 across 4 weeks, which included training with Dandenong Stingrays, Gippsland Power and Casey Demons VFL all taking training on various nights. This was enthusiastically received by both players and coaches inOur goal was to introduce a program that offered the players something that they may not have seen at local level of football. A strong emphasis was placed on the fundamentals, ground balls, kicking, marking and handballs. As the program proceeded, we introduced game sense drills that gave the players the opportunity to practice their fundamental skills but in a game environment, explaining why we train like this and the purpose of training the way we do. This then allowed us to develop match simulation drills hoping that the players would be able to implement this on game day. A high priority of our Academy was also the language. We wanted players to understand the words and phrases that they would be hearing if their football pathway took them to a higher standard, e.g VLine, Coates Hire futures U16's to Coates Hire U18's. We wanted to develop the 13's challenging the older age groups which would hopefully give them the opportunity to take the next step towards VLine. To let the players know that they are being watched in how they act, communicate with each other and how they generally hold themselves in society.

Our Academy wasn't only just about developing players, but also to help develop coaches so that they understood the language, the training drills and that they could take this information back to local level and make our league stronger and more productive in the development of talent. It also enhanced our Academy to run more proficient as we had more coaches understanding our direction of where we wanted to go.

Finally, we also wanted to instil, good, strong values in the playing group that would not only help develop their football, but also help develop them as young human beings. An appreciation of having this opportunity to train within the Academy and to respect it, was driven into the group. Appreciation of our families and the time and effort they give us as. If I could simplify what we wanted to achieve, I would put it as we wanted to, "bring the best version of themselves out".

I honestly believe we achieved these goals and will continue to get better in trying to set new standards and learn and develop us all. You never stop learning.

UMPIRE REPORT

I am pleased to present the Annual Report for the AFL South East Umpiring Department, reflecting on the remarkable year that was 2023. ACKNOWLEDGMENTS & TRANSITIONS

The registered umpire count increased from 409 to 644, contributing to a significant improvement in match appointment rates. For the MPFNL, an impressive milestone was achieved, with 100% of matches having Field Umpires appointed. Similarly, the SEWF witnessed a commendable 98% appointment rate, reflecting the commitment of our umpires to officiate at the highest standards. In our Junior competitions, over 90% of matches had Field Umpires appointed, showcasing the growth and development of our young umpires. This achievement would not have been possible without the dedication of our existing umpires, the recruitment efforts of our team, and the support of the broader AFL South East community. It is a testament to the collaborative spirit that defines our region.

APPOINTMENT OF RUSSELL DAVIDSON (Field Umpires Coach)

In a significant development, we welcomed Russell Davidson as the AFL South East Field Umpires Coach.
